sexuality, identity, relationships, the grocery store as metaphor, to name a few) and get a sense of how the art object may be altered going forward.

New this year, Blackfish presents the Lawrence Duckler New Arts Award to the artist who wins "best in show" as determined by the popular vote of visitors to the gallery before July 8th. The award is named for Dr. Lawrence Duckler, a beloved physician, father, husband, friend and staunch supporter of the arts in Portland, who believed in the importance of arts and artists in our society and the impact of their imagination on our present and future lives. **Blogger's Invitational:** Calling all arts bloggers and new media writers to a wine reception, organized by Blackfish with you in mind. Come together with your peers for a dialog about the effects of blogging culture on the Portland arts scene, and take in the Recent Grads show and the presentation of the Lawrence Duckler New Arts Award. Enjoy all this while mingling with artists and fellow arts writers.
